

TRUSTEE'S REPORT FOR VOTER'S METERING 11-10-2019

Our current copier was 10 years old so new copier was purchased with money from the memorial fund, for \$9,111

The main emphasis has been the church flooring project.

A short summary follows:

FLOORING PROJECT COMPLETE

The flooring project is now complete and the flooring committee would like to remind everyone what the project entailed:

- All new carpet in the chancel, nave, narthex, cry room, hall, copy room and the stairs to the balcony.
- The pews were reconfigured to allow more room on the side isles and more room between the pews (more knee room). The pews were cleaned and waxed.
- Pew cushions were shortened to match the reconfigured pews.
- The floors of the rooms on both sides of the chancel were recovered with vinyl.
- All base boards in the rooms mentioned above were removed and replaced with new material.
- The chancel, nave, narthex, cry room, balcony and hall were repainted.
- The carpet in the fire-side room, pastors office and Jackie's office were cleaned.
- The council approved \$80,000, from the memorial fund, for the flooring project and the total came cost came in under \$70,000.

FINANCIAL SECRETARY REPORT FOR VOTER'S MEETING 11-10-2019

We started 2018 with \$30,304 in retained earnings (reserve) and ended 2018 with \$24,428 in retained earnings or \$5876 negative (short of meeting our expenditures).

For 2019, as the end of October we are negative \$14,212 leaving us just \$10,644 in reserve.

NOTE: At the first of 2019 the church had an outside donation of \$5000 to our general fund. Without that donation we would have been negative \$19,212 and reserves would have been down to \$5,644
